- 1286 – 1308
 - Battle of Stirling Bridge (William Wallace)
 - Mongol realm is the largest empire in history

- 1777-1798
 - American Revolutionary War (1775-1783)
 - French Revolution (1789-1799)
 - Irish Rebellion (1798)
 - Declaration of the Rights of Man and the Citizen (1789)
 - US Constitution
 - Colonization of Australia (1778)
 - Uranus discovered (1781)
 - Discovery of Black Eye Galaxy and spiral Galaxy M61 (1780)

Mars & Venus Out Of Bounds

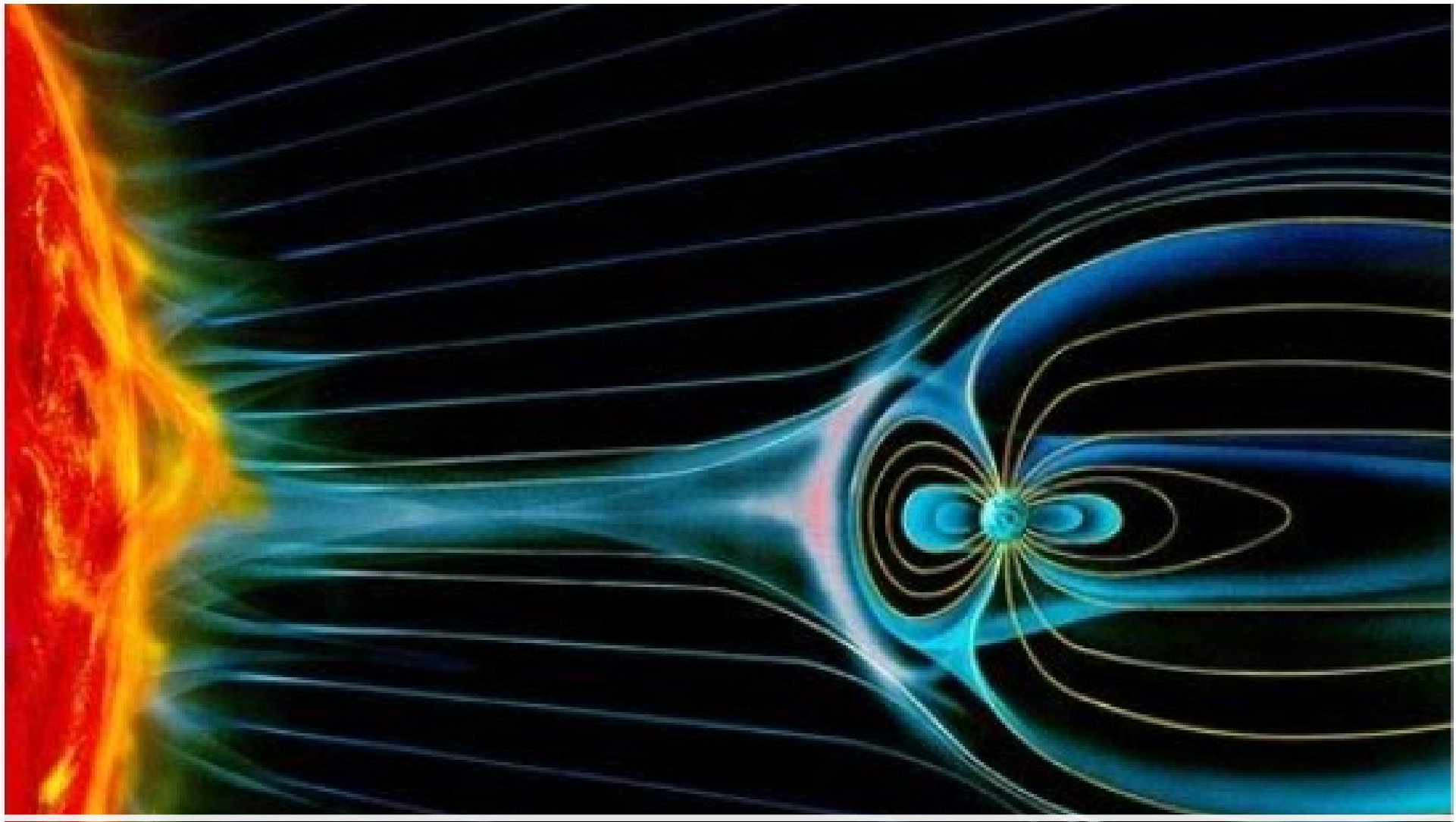


Apr 20, 2023 Eclipse will be seen over

South Pacific



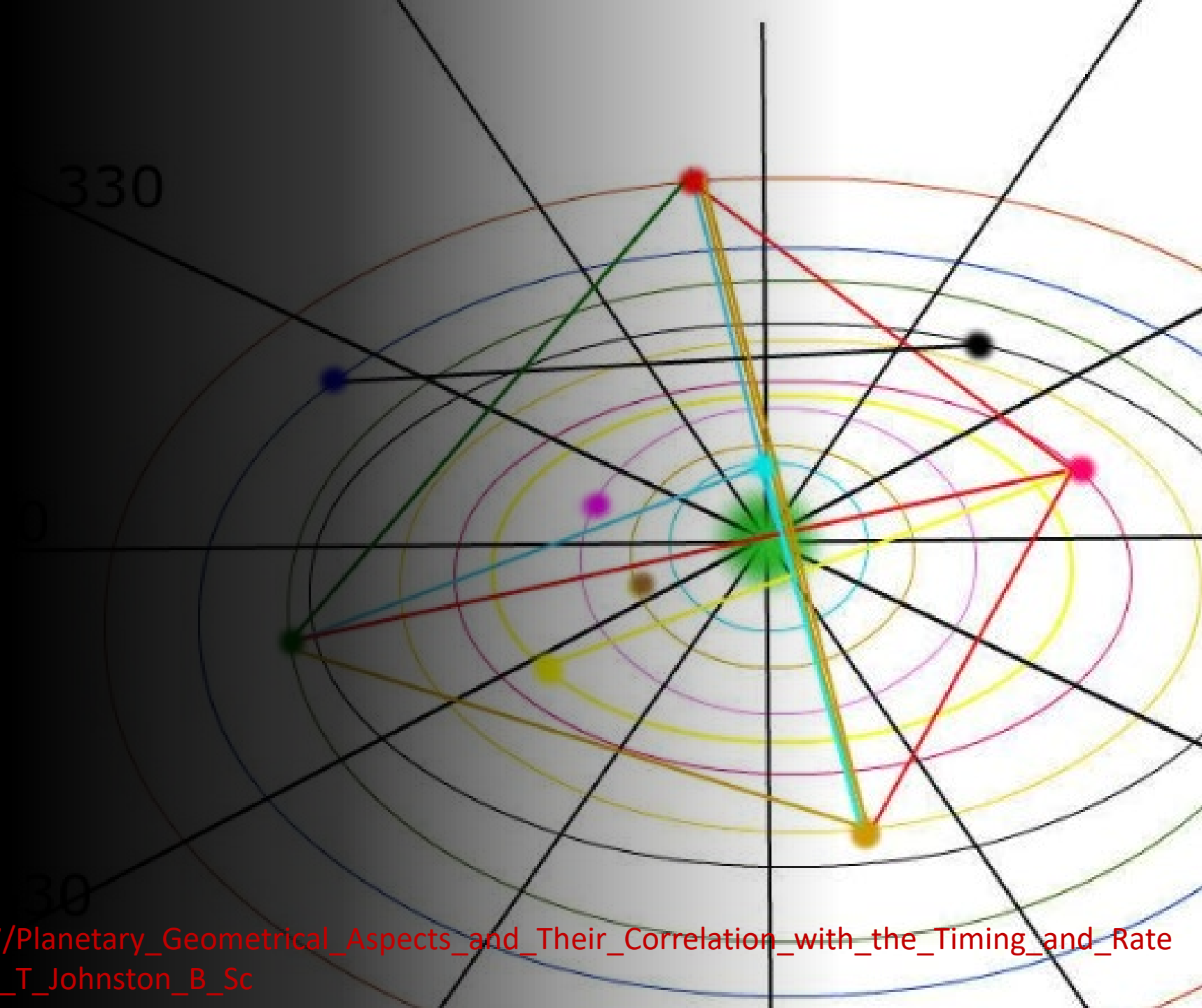


Geomagnetic Volatility

Astrological factors

- Supermoons (perigee – closest to Earth)
- Perihelion (planets approaching the Sun)
- Eclipses
- Harmonics (24^H or 15°)
- Number of aspects between planets
- Declination
- Retrogrades / planetary speed
- Outer planetary alignments

Planetary degrees almost exact

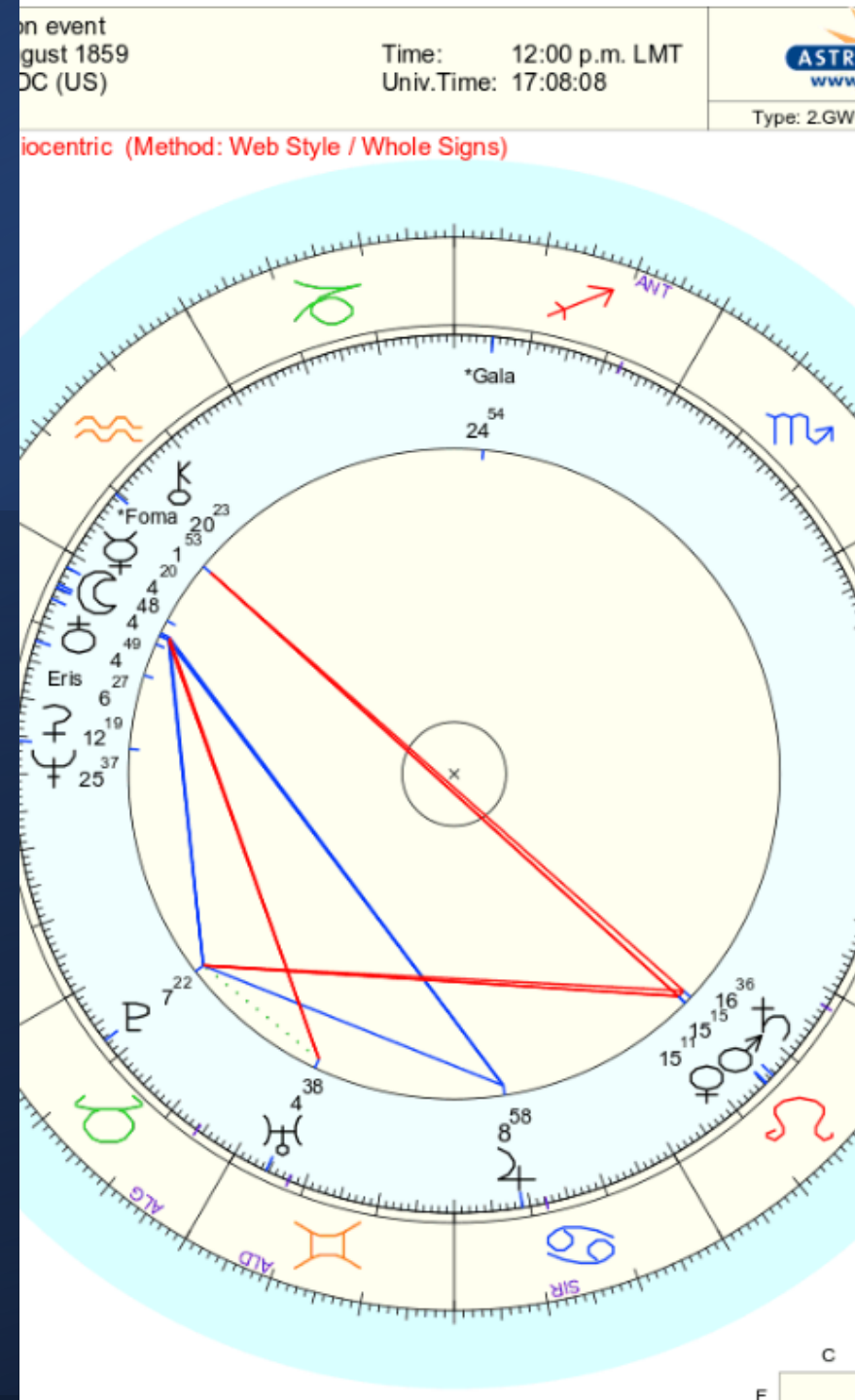
Mercury → Earth (15°)

Uranus → Earth (90°)

Pluto → Earth (62°)

Saturn → Mars (2°)

Pluto → Jupiter (60°)



Saturn-Neptune Cycle 2026

- 1737-1739 -- Outbreak of the Russo-Turkish war (1735-1739)
- 1773 -- Revolt of the English colonies in North America (1773-1775)
- 1809 -- Uprising of the Spanish colonies in Latin America (1810)
- 1846 -- Birth of Marxism (1847); European revolution February 1848
- 1882 -- Creation of the European socialist parties (1879 – 1883)
- 1917 -- The Russian Revolution. Mutinies in the warring armies
- 1952-1953 -- Death of Stalin (1953), Indochina war (1954). Growing 3rd world
- 1989 -- Fall of the Berlin Wall. Break up of USSR.

2026 -- **at 0° Aries.**
The last time Saturn and Neptune met in Aries was ~555 AD
Strong ties to Eastern Europe
Themes of Communism / Socialism / The “Left”
